

# CAMP TWIN LAKES – DREAM

- Camp Dream features two climate controlled lodges with multiple bedrooms, fully accessible bathrooms, and back porches for cabin group meetings, extra activity space, or as an outdoor hangout. Thanks to bunk beds donated by Gratus Capital Management, each lodge sleeps now up to 66 people.
- Dream’s outdoor pavilion is unique to our site. It holds our basketball court and is the center of camp where we do all of our spirit time, group initiatives, sports sessions, camp dances, and more!
- Adjacent to the pavilion is our center green space where campers participate in flagpole activities, carnival night, gaga ball, and group games!
- In addition to an outdoor pool, the Center for Therapeutic Recreation also features an indoor swimming pool and a fully-accessible beach and a lake front swimming area that provides a gradual entrance to the water!
- Boating activities include a launch system with grab bars to ease camper transfers from their wheelchairs into their watercraft of choice.
- Dream’s garden is where campers can enjoy learning about where their food comes from by working with different herbs and vegetables in wheelchair accessible raised beds.
- Dream’s Dining Hall offers campers a lake front view during meals and is a space for rainy day activity and other indoor programs. All meals and snacks are planned according to each camp’s dietary needs.
- Lake Dream was built by the Army Corps of Engineers. Campers enjoy such lake activities as boating, kayaking, canoeing, paddle boating, paddle boarding, and fishing.
- Camp Twin Lakes recently built an Outdoor Amphitheater on Lake Dream for campers to enjoy opening ceremonies and other performances.
- At archery, campers can shoot a bulls-eye with the help of specially trained staff and adaptive equipment.
- Camp Twin Lakes’ staff guides campers through several outdoor adventure activities including a 40-foot Zip Line, a new Climbing Tower, and Vertical Obstacle Course.
- Camp Dream has accessible nature trails so all campers can explore and enjoy the natural habitat that surrounds the campsite.
- Camp Dream’s Cycling program has bicycles for campers of all ages and sizes to enjoy, either on the road through camp or on the nature trails.
- CTL-Camp Dream has various creative arts programs, including improvisation and drama
- Campers also enjoy activities such as bowling and ceramics.
