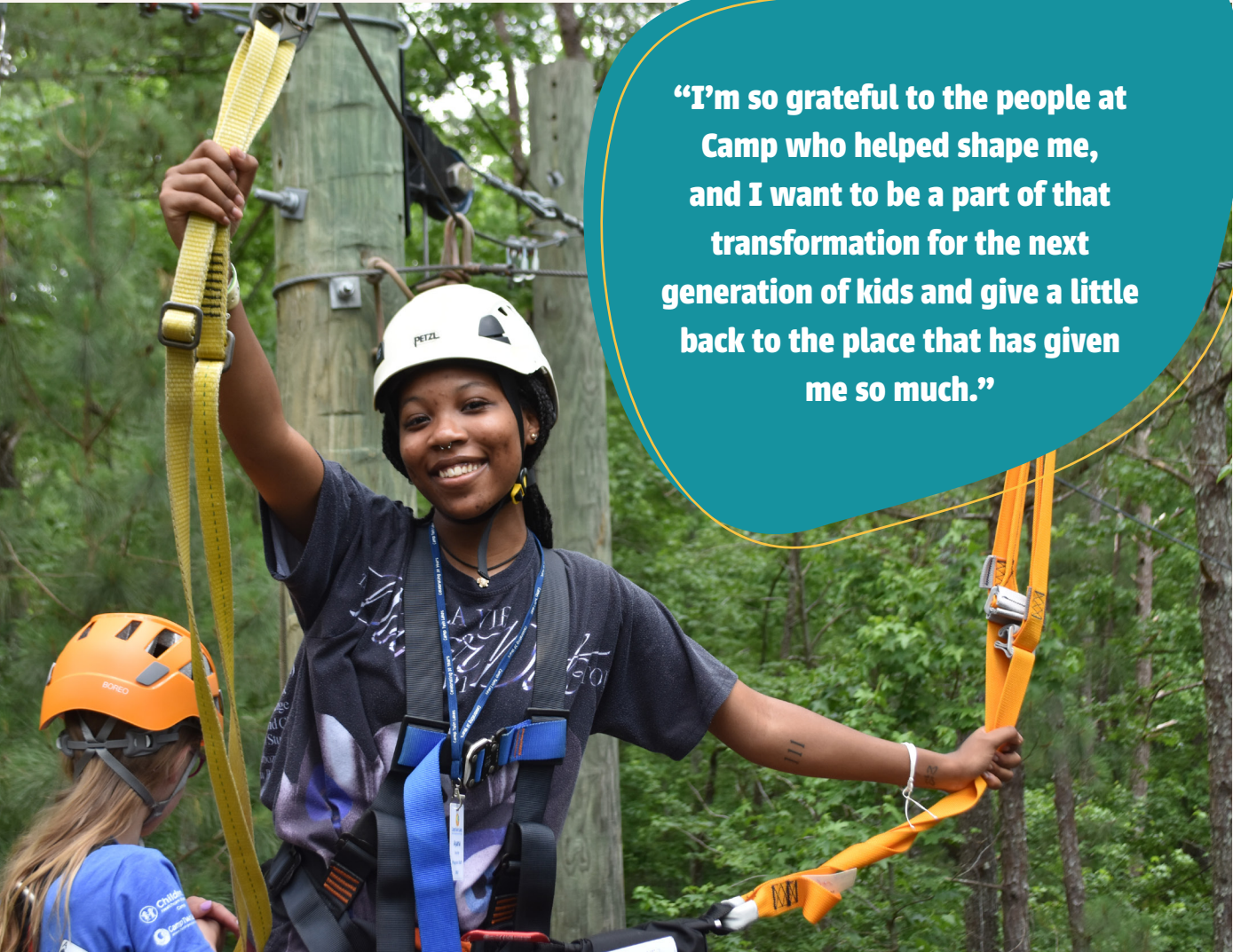

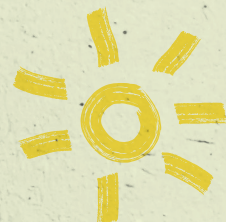

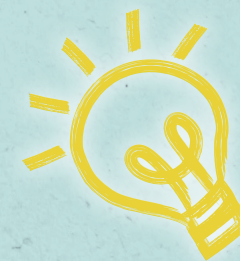

CAMP BUILDS CONFIDENCE

9-year-old Calvin has spent two summers attending Camp Blown Away, for kids with asthma. Last summer, as he prepared to venture off to Camp for the first time, he was nervous to leave his parents.

Shortly after arriving, Calvin made many new friends who also understood what it was like to have asthma. At Camp, he learned a lot about his asthma and grew more understanding of why it's important that he take his daily preventative medication.

His favorite part of Camp this year was catching a fish, which he had never done before, with only a bamboo rod and piece of bread for bait!

CAMP INSPIRES LEADERSHIP

In May, 19-year-old Jess traveled from her home in seaside Portsmouth, England to a rustic new world – Rutledge, Georgia. She had found a summer job at Camp Twin Lakes through an international camp staffing and cultural exchange agency. Jess wasn't sure what to expect at an American summer camp, but she found a strong community to navigate this new world: 17 other young people from 5 different countries who also chose to spend their summer working at Camp.

Jess admits her expectations for a deeply meaningful experience were low. Before leaving the UK, she had envisioned a typical summer camp experience full of s'mores, sunburns, and smiles. But Camp Twin Lakes had more to offer: Here, Jess gained **empathy** as she connected with kids facing special healthcare needs and life challenges, **confidence** as she successfully navigated new situations, and **leadership skills** as she led diverse groups of campers across the high ropes course. Jess found **joy** in the Camp community and left **empowered** to continue working with children who experience illnesses, disabilities, and life challenges.

TEEN LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

This summer, we introduced a new group of youth leaders to the Camp community. The K.I.T.E. (knowledge, integrity, teamwork, empathy) leadership program hosted 10 young community members for the opportunity to spend two weeks at Camp engaging with our mission and supporting our campers. During their stay, these students spent time with Camp leadership staff learning about Camp's core values, completing a service project, and modeling teamwork and leadership to campers.

A key piece of Camp programming is developing leadership skills among our campers and encouraging them along a path to serve as counselors and future program staff. Camp is a safe and supportive place to build and practice the skills that impact their whole lives!

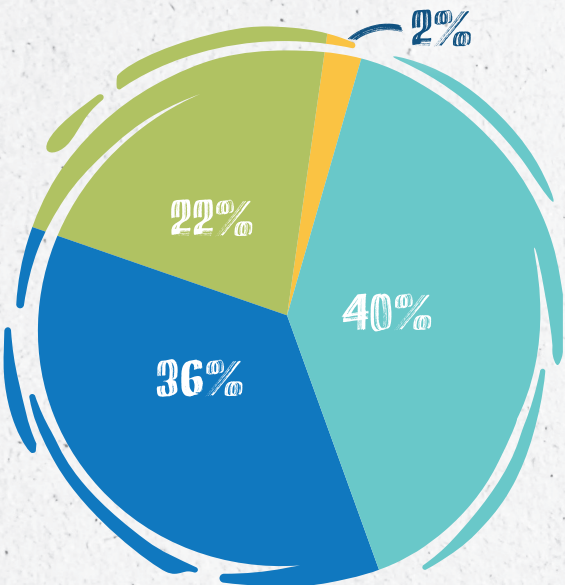

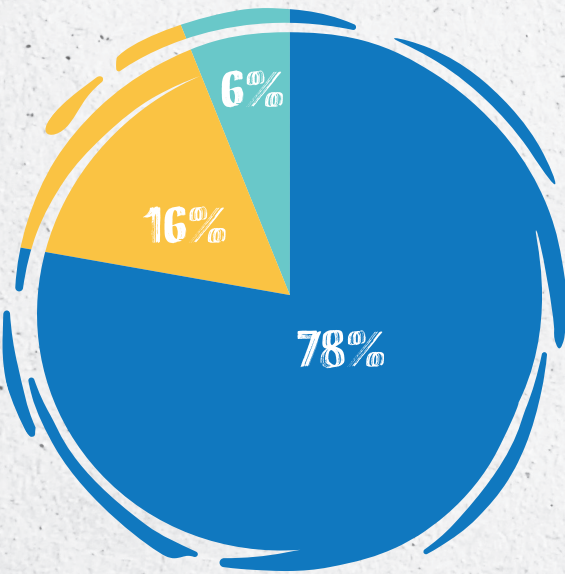

In addition to funds raised to support Camp's general operating expenses, Camp received \$597,658 in restricted contributions for our Growing Together Capital Campaign to build a third campus and \$661,537 in additional restricted contributions to support operations and small projects.

**Camp Twin Lakes subsidizes approximately 70% of the direct Camp cost for every camper through our donor-funded Camper Scholarship Program. The remaining costs are funded by our partnering organizations.

In addition to operating expenses, Camp Twin Lakes reported \$2,221,701 annual depreciation expense, a significant increase due to new assets at our Rutledge-West campus.

The operating surplus was used to fund major projects, like cabin renovations, dining hall and kitchen upgrades, and HVAC and septic system replacements.

*These financials exclude non-cash items such as depreciation, in-kind donations, and unrealized investment gains.
